

# LVN to ADN Transition Program

- The ADN Nursing program offers a revised 12 month LVN to ADN Transition Program.

## **TEAS-day of exam**


- **Photo ID:** To be admitted to your testing session, you will need to present proper photo identification, such as a driver's license, passport, or green card.
- **ATI Login Information:** Test takers who do not have their ATI username and password, will not be able to take the exam.
- **Writing Instrument:** Two sharpened No. 2 pencils with attached erasers. No other writing instruments are allowed.
- **You will not be allowed to test if you arrive to the testing center late.**



- **Declaratory orders**






