The Red River Promise allows graduating high school students to earn a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree without paying any out-of-pocket tuition costs. Plus, once you're enrolled, success coaches, academic advisors and faculty will continuously support you and keep you on track!

How? In Just 3 Easy Steps

1. PLEDGE

- > Submit your pledge by:



FEBRUARY 1

2. SUBMIT

- >> 10 Hours community service
JUNIORS ONLY
- >> College application to Promise partner college or university
- >> FAFSA or TASFA
- >> General college scholarship application



APRIL 1

3. REGISTER

- >> Register for classes for the fall semester by:



JULY 31



Note: When submitting your FAFSA, be sure to include any 4-year universities you are considering, in addition to NCTC, in your application.

Am I Eligible?

The Red River Promise Pledge opens on: **SEPTEMBER 1**

Please note, students must have the following to participate:

Program Requirements:

- >> Graduate from a Red River Promise partner high school.
- >> 10 hours of community service during junior year in high school.
- >> US citizens or non-US citizens must qualify for Texas residency.

Academic Persistence:

- > Must graduate high school on time within the academic year.
- > Enroll in college for the immediate fall semester following high school graduation.
- > Enroll each fall and spring semester until college completion.
